

PDA in Community Involvement

(SCQF* Level 7) (February - July 2017)

This award will extend or broaden professional or vocational skills and is linked to National Occupational Standards. It is for those who are working (paid or voluntary) within Community Learning and Development settings including CLD Practice, Capacity Building, Youth Work or Adult Learning.

The PDA will cover the principles and practice of involvement in community capacity building and the social context in which capacity building occurs.

Units covered include:

- Capacity Building
- Group Work
- Accountability for and Management of Resources

Furthermore, it will build on participants' existing knowledge and experience and serve as a progression route to further study at HNC/SVQ3/4 or University Degree level.

The award will be delivered by Third Sector Dumfries and Galloway in partnership with Dumfries and Galloway College.

The mode of delivery will be via a mixture of workshops/seminars and self directed study over an 18 week period (Feb - June) including 6 days attendance at Dumfries and Galloway College Campus, Dumfries.
