- To help everyone see the benefits of volunteering.
- To help organisations that work with volunteers.
- To make it easier for people to volunteer.
- To encourage training and learning chances for volunteers and organisations that work with volunteers so that volunteering is better.
- To help young people become volunteers.
- To support decision makers in organisations that work with volunteers, by giving advice and training.
- To make volunteering better for everyone.
- To celebrate volunteering in Dumfries and Galloway.
- To make 'Volunteer Dumfries and Galloway' a great place to find out about volunteering and how to look after volunteers.



How will we do what we say we are going to do?



We have developed a list of things to do.

We call this our action plan.

Our action plan has all the things we are going to do in the next 3 years to help volunteers and organisations.

We will check our action plan often and make sure we are doing everything we said we would do.
